CLAIM FOR LOSSES DUE TO WILDFIRE UNDER THE PROVINCIAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

I am pleased to announce that the municipality of the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District (District) has been designated as eligible for private damage claims under the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP). Residents and businesses may now apply for assistance for uninsurable wildfire-related losses incurred from June 25, 2015 to July 21, 2015.

Residents and businesses in Northern Settlements, Resort Subdivisions and areas within the District who submit their property taxes to the Northern Municipal Trust Account / Northern Municipal Services, can access PDAP forms through the following means:

Residents and businesses in incorporated municipalities, First Nations and parks may contact their local authority for more information on how to apply.

PDAP cannot accept emailed or faxed forms. All applications must be original, signed documents.

PDAP provides financial assistance to eligible claimants who have experienced uninsurable damage or loss to essential property due to a natural disaster event. Additional eligible wildfire-related loss coverage under PDAP may include extraordinary non-insurable costs such as dangerous tree removal and pre-emptive measures to protect eligible property; for example, fire breaks, fire guards and sprinklers. Applicants have six months from the date of the loss to report claims.

PDAP is not a substitute for private insurance nor does it provide full compensation for losses. PDAP provides assistance to return property to its pre-disaster value; expenses beyond that value will not be covered by PDAP.
